The United States Department of Justice, Office of Justice Programs, Bureau of Justice Assistance, recently announced a grant opportunity:

Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) Program FY 2011 Local Solicitation

The City of Tarpon Springs is eligible to apply for \$16,604. These funds are available for a period of four years. The funds are restricted to a unit of local government that performs law enforcement functions. Purpose areas include law enforcement programs and prevention and education programs.

The City of Tarpon Springs Police Department intends to apply for these funds to support and enhance our community policing philosophy and programs.

The local solicitation grant, if awarded, will be used to fund the Community Officers in Public Schools Program (COPS) and prevention and education programs conducted by the School Resource Officers on campus.
