IDENTIFICATION NEEDED

The Tarpon Springs Police Department is attempting to identify the remains of a man discovered on January 12, 2005.

The pictured composite was created from skeletal remains that were discovered in a wooded area in the 44000 block of U.S. 19 in Tarpon Springs on 01/12/05. The victim died from an apparent self inflicted gunshot wound. His physical description is: W/M, approx. 40-55 years of age, 508-603, possible salt and pepper colored hair.

The following clothing was discovered on the victim:

Size 10.5 Cross Trekker sneakers

denim pants (size 38x34) w/ a white rope around the waist that was being utilized as a belt

Colored medium sized button down shirt and a dark colored knit type watch cap
